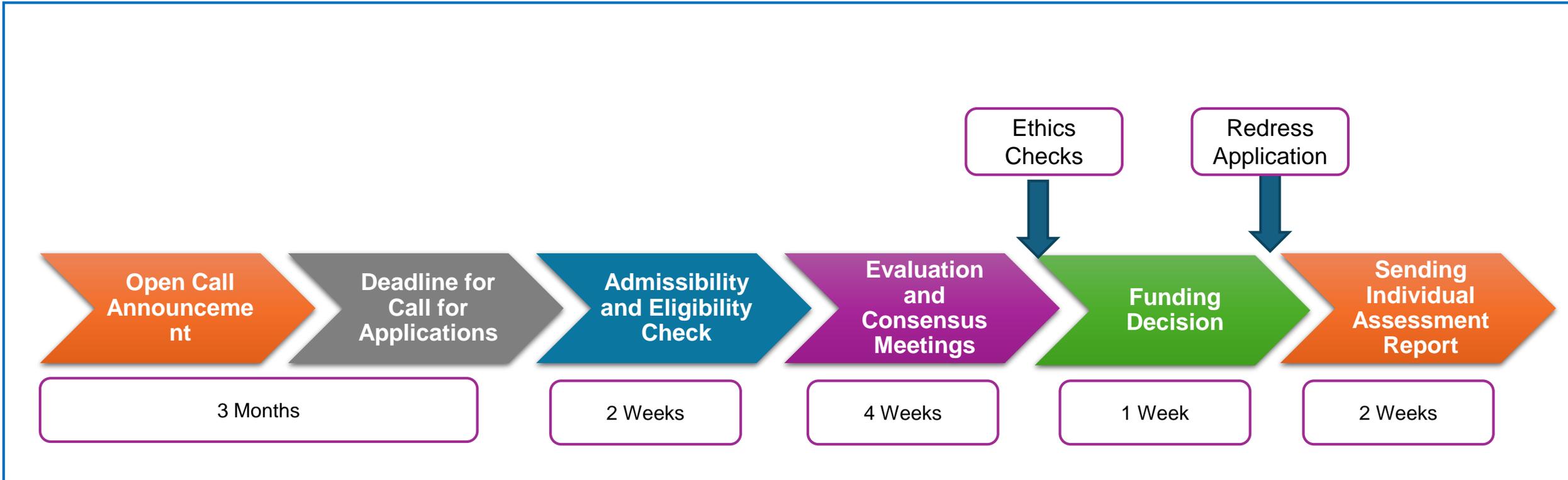

## General Eligibility

**No age or nationality restrictions:** Open to postdoctoral researchers of any origin; no limits on origin or destination.

**Postdoctoral status:** Must hold a PhD by the call deadline (Dec 1, 2025). Successful thesis defenders (unconditional, pre-deadline) are eligible; documentation may be required.

## Mobility Rule

Applicants must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in Türkiye for more than 12 months within the 36 months immediately preceding the deadline of the relevant CoCirculation3 call.

Excludes short stays (20 days/year) and compulsory national service.

## Additional Conditions

**Green Deal priority:** Projects are expected to be related to Türkiye's Green Growth Roadmap and EU Green Deal RDI topics.

**Employment Status:** Researchers who are already permanently employed by their proposed host institution are not eligible for funding under CoCirculation3. However, applicants may propose a different host, provided they terminate their existing contract upon funding and sign a new fixed-term one with the host.

**Turkish nationals:** Cannot apply if subject to mandatory service obligation from prior fellowships/support in Türkiye.



- Applicants CAN CHOOSE as their main host organisation ANY academic or non-academic research institute in Turkey with a high international research reputation.
- Potential host organizations are encouraged to initiate their own recruitment process through;

- The quality of the host organization and supervisor will be reviewed during the evaluation process
- All researchers must have access to laboratory and/or office space that is needed for the proper implementation
- All researchers must have access to all infrastructure and equipment needed to carry out the project.

<b>Definition</b>	Temporary assignment in an academic or non-academic institution, in Türkiye or abroad, aligned with the research project and offering added value. <b>Timing</b>	During the fellowship duration, but not allowed during the last 6 months.	Only after the standard fellowship duration ends.

**€3,980/month** gross living allowance paid to recruited researchers via host organizations; taxable in Türkiye as a contribution to salary costs.



**€600/month** family allowance for researchers with families; fixed and taxable in Türkiye.



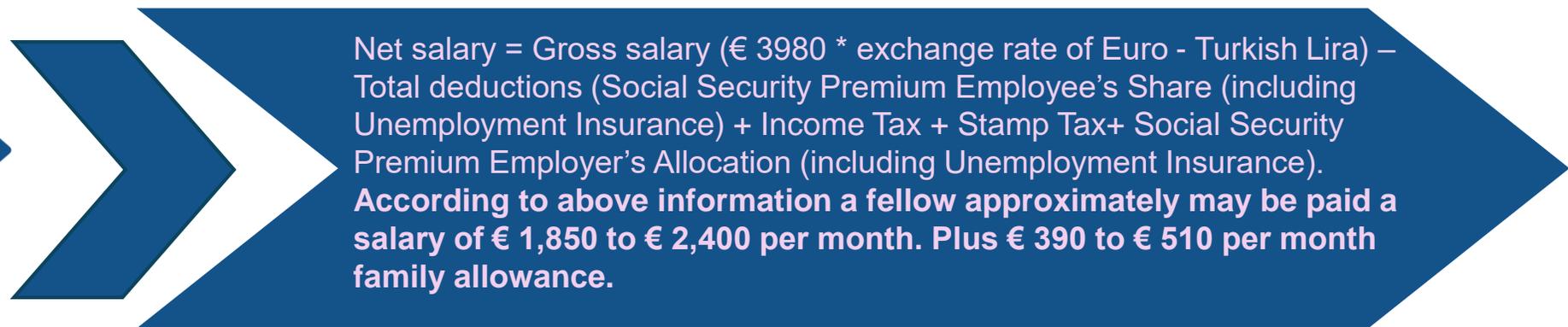
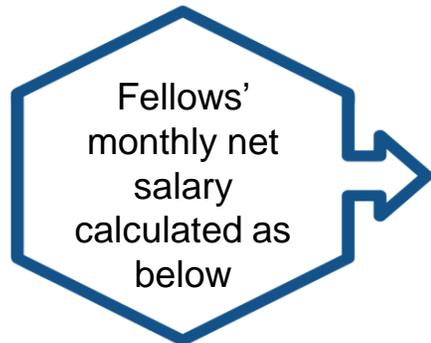
**€1,000/month** research allowance managed by the host organization to cover project-related expenses (e.g., training, conferences, research costs); fellows must report usage in 6-monthly reports.



**€130/month** for handling salary payments, research training, networking budget, and fellowship formalities at the host level.



**Up to €250/month** for max 12 months to support training, consultancy, and services enhancing researchers' entrepreneurial activities (upon invoice submission).



The training program encompasses courses and workshops focused on non-scientific competencies, designed to broaden fellows' skill sets, expedite their professional advancement, and facilitate networking opportunities among CoCirculation3 participants, including interactions with TÜBİTAK staff.

## Core Principles

- Fundamental ethics principles
- CoCirculation3 adheres to EU Charter of Fundamental Rights and Horizon Europe ethics rules.

## Proposal Requirements

- All applicants must fill ethical issues table – attached to the proposal, incomplete declarations lead to rejection.
- Specify any project activities involving ethics; expert review may require approval even if deemed unnecessary.

## Approval Process

- All proposals reviewed by Ethical Committee (EC); may require host institution's ethics approval letter.
- If no host ethics committee, use nearest local one.
- Approvals must be obtained and submitted to TÜBİTAK before project start.

## IPR Protection

- Host institutions must establish rules to protect and manage intellectual property from research.

## TÜBİTAK IPR Regulations

- All projects, including CoCirculation3, comply with TÜBİTAK IPR laws. IPR holders must grant TÜBİTAK a free license if requested.

## Scientific Publications

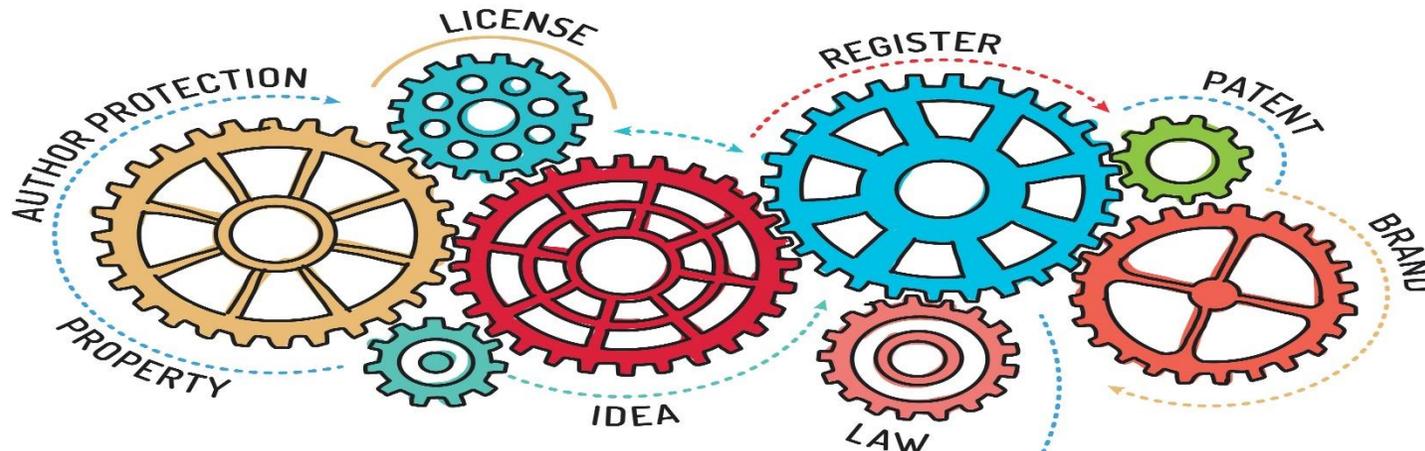
- Fellows must acknowledge TÜBİTAK and REA support via CoCirculation3 in all project-related publications.

## Public Announcements

- Host institutions and fellows must credit TÜBİTAK in press releases and announcements; use TÜBİTAK logo per official website standards (except where restricted, e.g., theses/articles).

## Liability

- Researchers are liable for damages from non-compliance with these rules.





## Required Documents

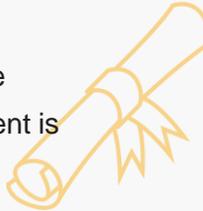
### Research Proposal and CV

- Research proposal with Ethical issues table filled in full
- Curriculum vitae for the applicant and supervisor



### Diploma

The original PhD diploma or a certified doctoral degree graduation certificate must be submitted. If the document is not originally issued in Turkish or English, a translated version must also be provided.



### Letter of Support

A Letter of Support from the host institution which must be approved by the rector, vice-rector or the head of a non-academic institution.  
Applications that include a secondment proposal must also include a Letter of Support from the co-host institution.



## Application

❑ Applicants are expected to present their proposal in 5 different sections:

- ❑ Excellence
- ❑ Impact
- ❑ Quality and Efficiency of the Implementation
- ❑ Ethical aspects (if any)
  - ❑ The maximum total length for sections 1 to 3 is 10 pages, plus 1 page for the Start Page, 1 for the Table of Contents.
  - ❑ The CV should include the standard academic and research record (maximum 5 pages are recommended).
  - ❑ The template is available at the <https://cocirculation3.tubitak.gov.tr/>
  - ❑ No page limit in Ethical aspects
- ❑ Scope of Project's Alignment with the European Green Deal
  
- ❑ Any research career gaps and/or unconventional paths should be clearly explained
- ❑ Applicants should clearly explain the added value of implementing their research project in a non-academic host organisation (if non-academy is chosen)



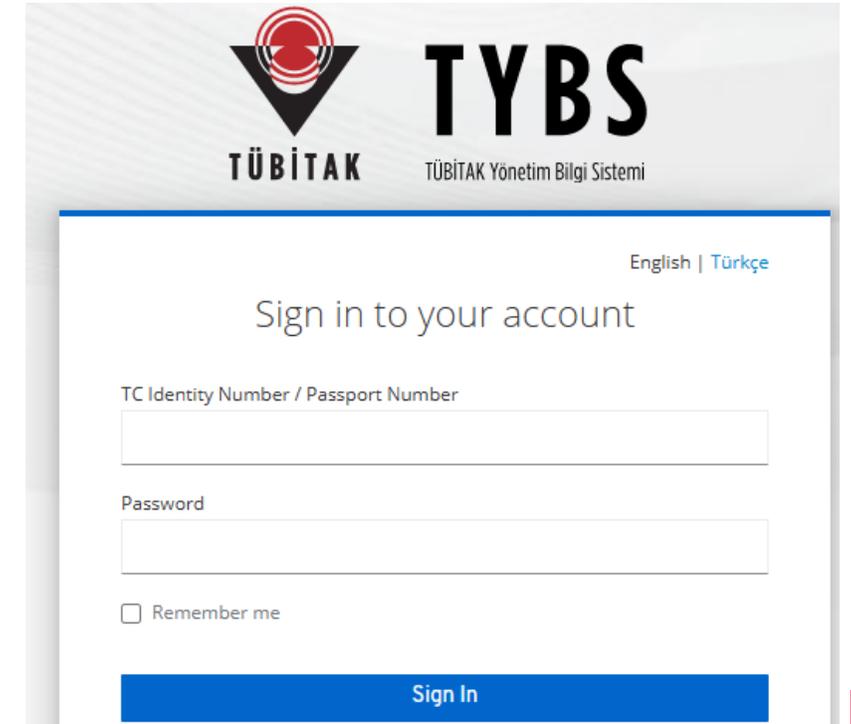
At the application stage, applicants are not required to submit any documents for the verification of the mobility rule. However, if candidates are awarded the support, **they must provide documents proving their compliance with the mobility rule along with the fellowship initiation documents.**

## Account Creation

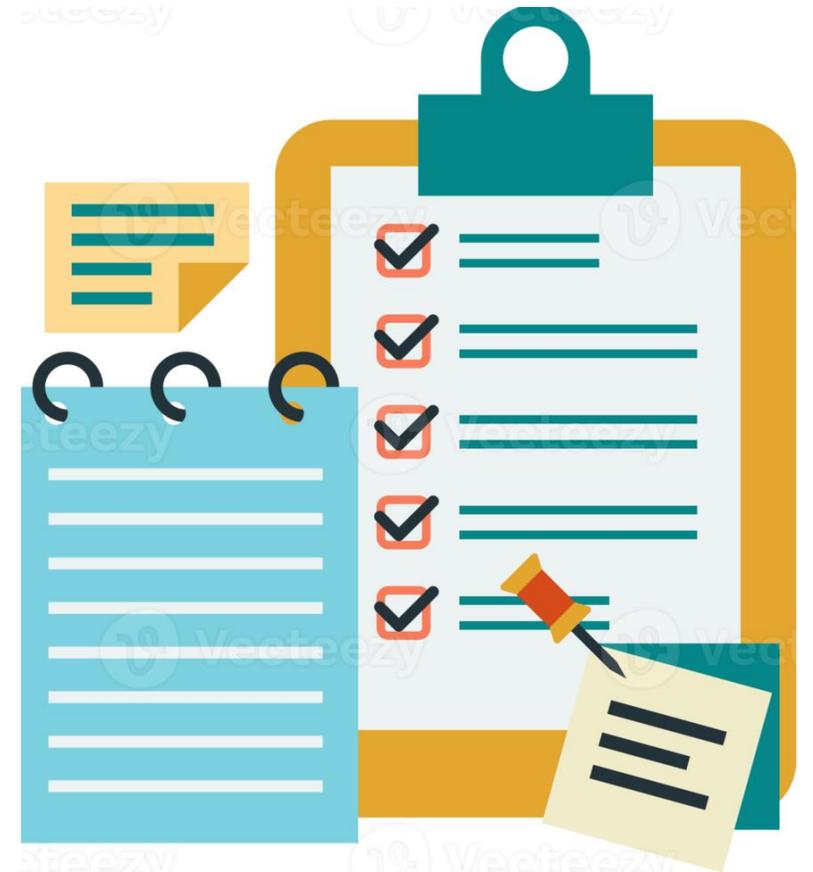
- Applicants have to create an account entering required Identity and contact information into Researchers Information System (ARBİS) <https://arbıs.tubitak.gov.tr/>
- Once account created at ARBİS, applicants can start online application at TÜBİTAK MIS (<https://tybs.tubitak.gov.tr/> )
- For the technical problem, the applicants can contact with IT department at [cocirculation3@tubitak.gov.tr](mailto:cocirculation3@tubitak.gov.tr) .

## Document Uploading

- All the documents have to be in pdf format.
- Certified PhD diploma or certified copy most recently completed university degree might be in jpeg

- An applicant may continue on the TYBS System to modify his/her application and submit revised versions overwriting the previous one until the deadline.
- Once the researcher finalizes application, the application process will be finalized and the application form will be automatically generated.
- Incomplete applications will not be moved to the eligibility check phase.
- No hard copies of the application documents are required.
- Submission of proposals is recommended at least 48 hours before the deadline of the call.





**Mobility Rule:** As an international PhD program enrollee, I carried out my doctoral research in Türkiye, exceeding 12 months of residency there within the relevant 36-month period. Does this disqualify me from eligibility?

**The call requires no residency or main activity in Türkiye in the last 36 months. Doctoral studies count as main activity. If enrolled in an overseas PhD program with supporting documents (e.g., student certificate, lease agreement), you meet the condition.**



**Is there any format for Letter of support?**

There is no specific format for the Letter of Support. However, it should include:

- Project title and researcher's full name
- Program name (CoCirculation3)
- A statement confirming that, if funded under CoCirculation3, the host institution agrees to host the researcher and employ them under a fixed-term contract for the project duration.



**Is there a remote working option under the program?**

**No.** The researcher is expected to work full-time at the host institution within the scope of the project.

**Is it possible to be a supervisor for more than one project?**

**Yes.**



**If I start working as a permanent staff member at the host institution during the application process, will my application still be valid?**

**No.** The European Commission states that the employment contract held under the researcher's existing position cannot be used in place of the one for CoCirculation3, and that the researcher must work full-time for the CoCirculation3 project.

**Will my support continue if I start working at the host institution after my support has begun?**

**In this case, the European Commission decides whether the support will continue. The decision is made by taking into account the status of the project, the researcher's situation, etc.**



**Which research fields are eligible for applications?**

Applications are accepted from all fields. Project proposals are expected to be directly or indirectly aligned with the Green Deal.



**When can I start the project? within 5 months after the support decision. Msc pf bas**



**Can I apply to both 2232 and the CoCirculation3 program at the same time?**

**Yes, if you are accepted into both programs, you will need to choose one.**



**I have applied for an MSCA PF. Can I apply with the same project proposal?**

**Yes.**
