1. BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES OF COOPERATION

Based on the Memorandum of Understanding between The Scientific and Technological Research Council of Türkiye (TÜBİTAK) and National Research Foundation of the Republic of Korea (NRF) signed in 2012, this call is launched to enhance the cooperative activities in the field of research between two countries.

The main objective of this call is to support mobility of scientists to promote the integrated joint research between two countries through the synergy between both countries' teams.

As a part of this agreement, each country's agencies evaluate the proposals of their respective national teams on projects selected according to their own priorities.

The purpose of the partnership between TÜBİTAK and NRF is to support mobility of scientists for which there is genuine Turkish-Korean collaboration. **There is no restriction for the research themes.**

2. ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

For Turkish team, The Principal Investigator (PI), is expected to hold a PhD degree if they are from the academy. If the PI is from the public or private sector, they must have a BA/BSc Degree. Also, if the PI is from the private sector, they should be a full time employee of their company for at least a minimum of 6 months. Proposals may be submitted by public legal RTD (Research and Technology Development) entities, higher education institutions, non-university research establishments from public sector, and private sector. 3. SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

Turkish and Korean partners need to prepare a joint proposal. Teams from each country must designate a national principal investigator. Proposals should be submitted in parallel to respective funding agencies by each national principal investigator. **There is no late submission deadline for either Turkish or Korean teams.** Proposals that are not submitted on both sides will not be accepted for evaluation. Hence, Turkish/Korean project leaders should make sure that their counterpart submits a matching application to their funding institution.

Online submission has to be completed through <http://uidb-pbs.tubitak.gov.tr/> until **30 June 2026, 23:59 pm**. Applications can be completed with Electronic-signature. Accordingly, members of the Turkish research groups need to have personal e-signatures. Deadline for E-signatures is **7 July 2026, 23:59 pm**.

4. EVALUATION

Proposals are evaluated by TÜBİTAK and NRF independently by their own evaluation procedures. Only the proposals which are accepted by both sides can be funded. **Maximum 7 projects** will be funded within this call.

Eligibility Check:

Each proposal received within the designated submission deadline shall pass through an administrative/eligibility check by both Managing Authorities. The administrative/eligibility check procedure is defined in the respective National Rules & Regulations set forth by each Managing Authority. For applications to be eligible to move forward to the scientific evaluation stage, applicants will need to satisfy the criteria set forth by both Managing Authorities.

5. FUNDING PROVISIONS

Each project will be funded for a period of 2 years (24 Months). Each agency will cover expenditures for their respective country's teams according to their own rules. Turkish teams will be funded based on TÜBİTAK 1071 Program. Korean researchers will be funded under the Regulation for the National R&D Program Management of Korea.

Post-award:

For successful projects, the PI from each country will sign a Grant Agreement directly with the respective Managing Authority. The National Rules & Regulations will form an integral part of each respective Agreement, which will further define the terms and conditions, including the funding disbursement schedule for both parties. Projects must start and end on the same date for all partners within the project consortium.

Other requirements that are specifically required by each of the Managing Authorities will need to be adhered to by the said counterparts.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Project partners are required to establish and sign an agreement on the ownership and management of intellectual property rights arising from the joint research and development activities. This agreement must specify the distribution of rights, rules for exploitation, IP management procedures, and the competent court and applicable law for dispute resolution.

The drafting, negotiation, and finalization of this agreement are the sole responsibility of the project partners. The participating funding agencies do not provide or endorse any model agreement. Funding for awarded projects must only be requested and initiated after the agreement has entered into force.

The terms agreed by the partners must not conflict with national laws, regulations, terms and conditions of TÜBİTAK and NRF. The signed agreement must be submitted to TÜBİTAK and NRF upon request.
